- Registry Information Service on European Residents started in 2004 as an innovative eGovernment service under the eTEN Programme of the European Commission.
- Objective: Deployment of an One-Stop-Portal for Business to verify address information in European official public registers.
- Challenge: Every member state has other legal, technical and semantic requirements.

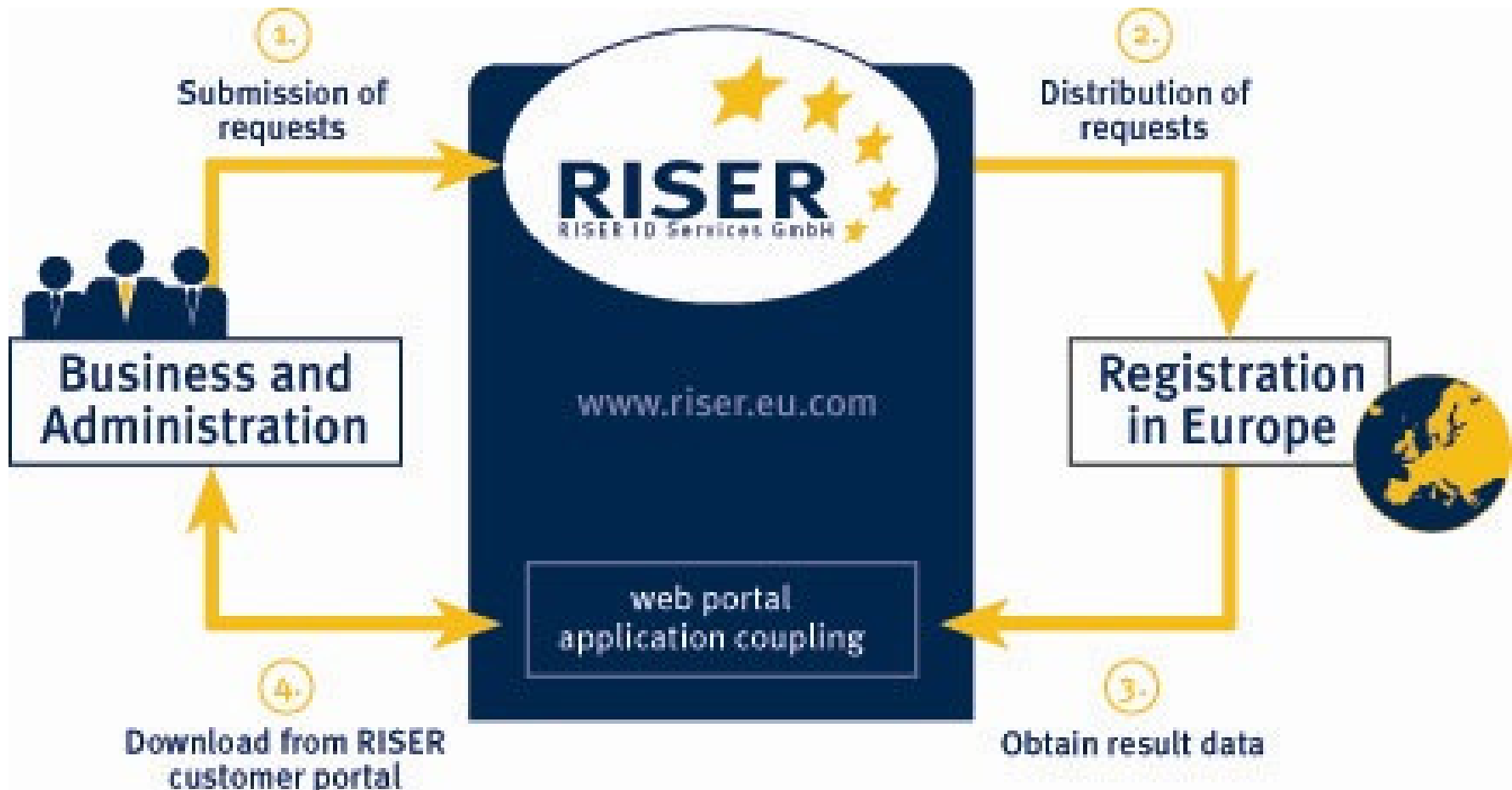

# Relevance



- Population register is a base register for public administration.
- Verification and updating of address information in official population registers is one of the most frequently used services in public administration.
- The economy is dependent on the possibility to verify address data against valid and trustworthy registries.
  - Registration of new customers
  - Updating of customers address data
  - Debt collection

# Obstacles



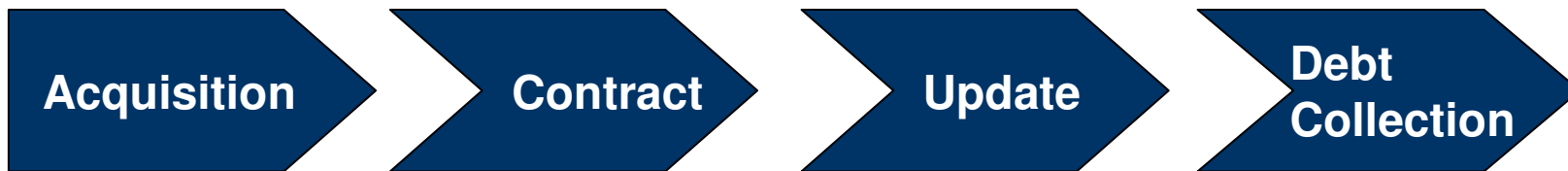
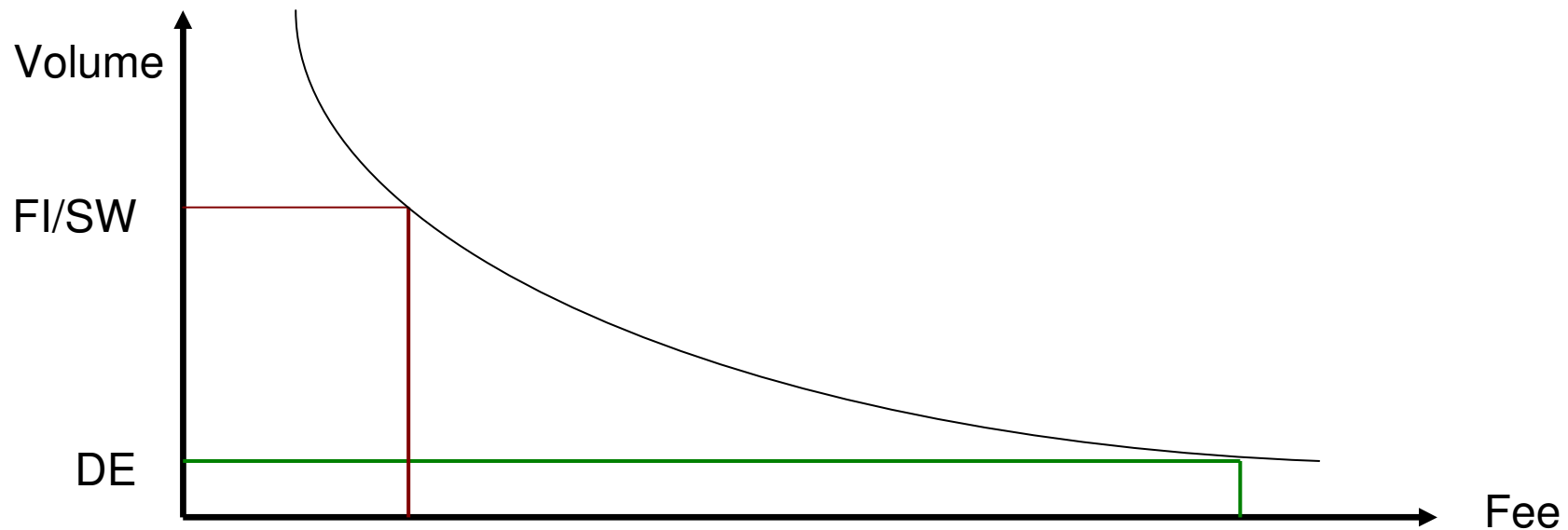
- Specific legal, organisational and technical requirements for each Member State
- Paper based processing of data
- Different access procedures
- Different fee structures
- Different quality of address data
- Different search facilities
- No co-ordination of data exchange on European level

# Registry data



- Data is valid and up-to-date (residents are obliged to register).
- Authority controls safeguards for the disclosure of personal data.
- Only limited part of information is disclosed.
- If no registry data is available the data will be offered by private data providers

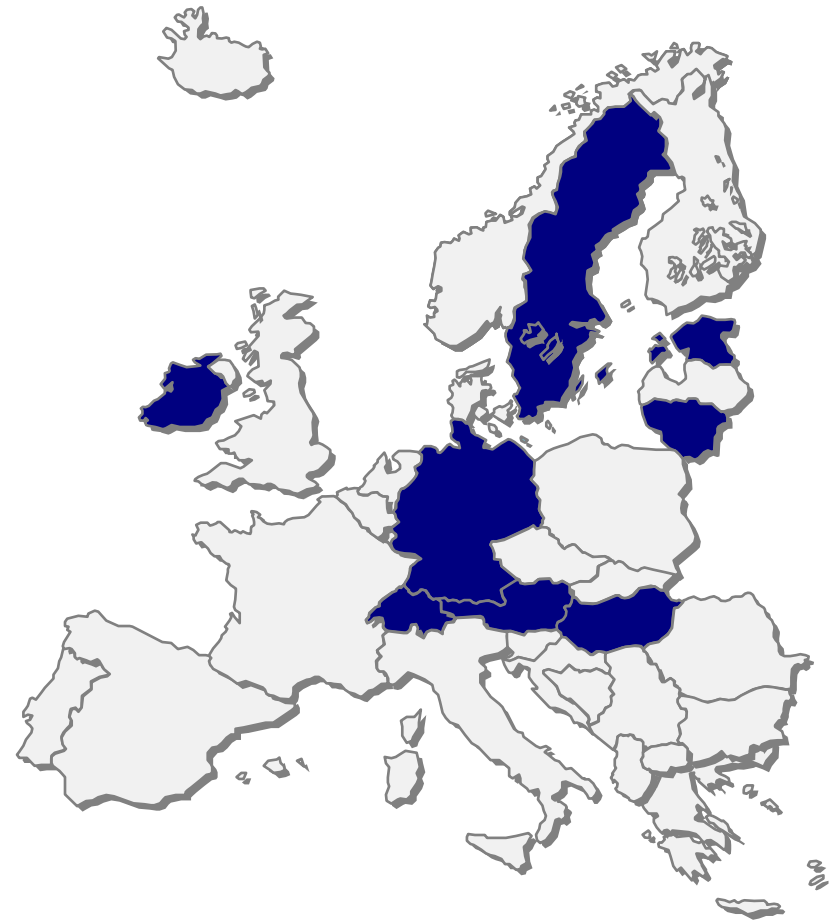
